

PARENTAL INVOLVEMENT – TITLE I

The education of students is a cooperative effort involving the school, parents and the community. The district will carry out programs, activities and procedures, which include the involvement of parents in regular, two-way, and meaningful communication involving student academic learning and other school activities. The district recognizes that parents play an integral role in assisting their child's learning and encourages parents to be actively involved in their child's education.

The district shall:

- A. Put into operation programs, activities and procedures for the involvement of parents in all of its Title 1 schools consistent with federal laws. Those programs, activities and procedures will be planned and operated with meaningful consultation with parents of participating children;
- B. Work with its schools to ensure that the required school-level parental involvement policies meet the requirements of federal law;
- C. To the extent practicable, provide full opportunities for the participation of parents with limited English proficiency, parents with disabilities, and parents of migratory children, including providing information and school reports in an understandable and uniform format in a language parents understand including alternative formats upon request; and
- D. Provide opportunities for parents of children served in Title I, Part A schools to participate in decisions about how the 1 percent of Title I, Part A funds reserved for parental involvement is spent.
