

FREEDOM OF EXPRESSION

The free expression of student opinion is an important part of education in a democratic society. Students' verbal and written expression of opinion on school premises is to be encouraged so long as it does not disrupt the operation of the school. Students are expressly prohibited from the use of vulgar, racist, sexist and/or offensive terms in classroom or assembly settings.

The superintendent and/or designee shall develop procedures assuring that students are able to enjoy free expression of opinion while maintaining orderly conduct of the school.
